### **APEX FOUNDATION WORK GROUP CREATED**

#### ***AFWG 2006 Will Work at Three Charity Organizations in India***

**HERNDON, VA – March 13, 2006** – Apex CoVantage, through its private foundation, announced that it has formed the first Apex Foundation Work Group (AFWG 2006). The group is comprised of Apex employees and their families and was created to facilitate individual participation in group volunteer efforts to provide aid to charity organizations throughout the world.

Later this month, members of AFWG 2006 will travel to India to provide much needed assistance to several charitable organizations throughout the country. They will first visit the Association of People with Disability (APD) in Bangalore to paint and repair several of the organization's buildings, including the Communications and Fund Raising Offices. They will also repair office furniture and clean up children's playgrounds at APD. AFWG 2006 will then visit the Child Aid Project in Vijayawada to paint and repair the organization's classrooms and office buildings and refurbish the playground. Finally, AFWG 2006 will visit the Mandal Primary School, part of the Krushi Project, in Hyderabad to clean, repair and paint the school's classrooms and facilities. The charity work that AFWG 2006 will perform in India is the first of many charitable initiatives planned throughout the world.

“The Apex Foundation Work Group was created to help the less fortunate throughout the world,” says John Kuranz, President of Apex's RCS Division and organizer of the Apex Foundation Work Group. “It is truly a blessing to be able to work hand-in-hand with the Foundation organizations and make a difference in the lives of others.”
